World Investment Conference: Delhi Roadshow 12 December 2011

CII - Delhi organised The World Investment Conference: Delhi Road Show on 12 December 2011.

The gathering comprised manufacturers from the FMCG; specialty chemicals and hi-tech spaces, finance and advisory; tax, accountancy, legal experts, money managers, academia, as well as institutional representational from embassies; trade and investment bodies; trade associations; and consultancies.

The workshop began with a value proposition of the WIC, proceeding with a film screening. Mr Jean-Bernard Guerree, CEO, World Investment Conferences, SAS, highlighted the burgeoning interest that Europe is showing in India. This is well established by rising FDI flows over the past decade.

Mr Poul Jensen, Director, European Business and Technology Centre, who has spent several years in India said that the greatest challenge between Indo-European relations lies in the different perceptions between the two regions, perceptions on price, time, quality and transparency.

Ms Rekha Khanna, Managing Director, Biomerieux India Pvt Ltd, said that Biomerieux success lies in successful merger of both Western and Indian ideals and the senior management acknowledging that it could not operate at the same profit margins as in North America and Europe divisions of the company.

More importantly, she stressed that the success behind Biomerieux's Indian business laid in combining the company's vision and mission with the local market scenario in India.

CII report on "Investment Climate in Delhi"

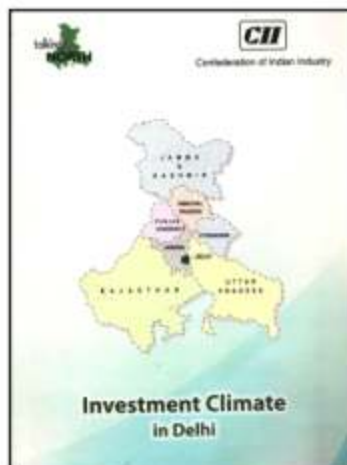
CII Delhi released a report, titled "Investment Climate in Delhi"; the seventh report in Talking North series. The series is an endeavour to benchmark the progress of the northern region vis-à-vis other regions on various aspects, and also compare the states within the region.

The objective of the report is to provide the status and development of various macroeconomic parameters such as economic growth, health, education, investment policies, fiscal stability etc.

The report highlights the skilled labour base of Delhi supported by robust infrastructure essential for the development of service sector. With the changing economic scenario and technological advancement, the State provides scope for investments in Knowledge based, Service Sector, IT/ITeS type of industries.

During the period 2004-05 to 2009-10, the state's economy grew at an annual rate of 10.6%. This growth has been led by the services sector, which grew at 11.5%. The New Industrial Policy of the state with its focus on hi-technology and knowledge based industrial activities coupled with procedural simplifications and e-governance, has facilitated the new investment opportunities.

On the social development front the State ranks 4th on the Human Development Index (HDI), 2006 reflecting linkage between economic and social development.
