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

- Establishing a programme for DSHEA GMP training and 3rd party certification in India
- Preshipment check → US FDA & EIC dialogue
- Looking for 2-3 National Dossiers u/Botanical Drug registrations
- Scientist exchange programme CCRAS-NCNPR
- Commission 'Therapy' based trials protocol
- Massive scientific awareness programme
- Rasa preparation safety profiling & characterisation





Mission Mode - THMPD

- Initial news talks of a successful engagement and dialogue between stakeholders
- 4 way plan :
 - a. Putting THMPD to test draft TM dossier
 - b. Getting herbal monographs accepted
 - c. Setting a lobby / engagement / awareness agenda
 - d. WTO protest against a trade barrier

XIth Plan - AYUSH Research



- 1) Project to establish an autonomous National Institute of AYUSH/THS (similar to IIT or AIIMS) in public private partnership mode Rs. 350 Cr.
- Program to identify and strengthen Advanced Centres for basic and applied research in AYUSH/THS and identify flagship research projects - Rs. 10 Cr.
- 3) Program for Capacity Building of AYUSH/THS institutes Rs. 10 Cr.
- 4) Scheme to promote 'Science Initiatives in AYUSH/THS' (SIA) and Golden Triangle Project (GTP) for Global Leadership. Rs. 120 Cr.
- 5) Establishment of network of centres for AYUSH/THS informatics Rs. 36 Cr.
- 6) Scheme for Development of Trans-disciplinary Research Methodology Rs. 20 Cr.
- 7) Harmonization of Intramural and Extramural research between AYUSH/THS institutions and promote basic and applied research in national and global priorities/need based areas. Rs. 210 Cr.



XIth Plan - AYUSH Industry



- 8) Scheme for promotion of entrepreneurship in the AYUSH sector. Rs. 150 Cr.
- 9) Schemes for development of Standards and Quality norms for AYUSH ingredients, formulations and processes as per AYUSH principles Rs. 31 Cr.
- 10) Schemes for Development of new formulations, technologies, tools and practices with validation of existing products and procedures Rs. 50 Cr.
- 11) Scheme for Technology Upgradation and Modernisation for the AYUSH Industry Rs. 125 Cr.
- 12) Scheme to Identify, promote and develop "Star product(s) for the International market" and Brand promotion for the ASU sector domestically and internationally Rs. 300 Cr.
- 13) Scheme for formation of AYUSH Pharmacopoeia Commission Rs. 25 Cr.
- 14) General Policy Initiatives for promotion of AYUSH Industry Rs. 30 Cr.
